



Safety in the Buildings

Sayers Croft has a very good safety record but analysis has shown that many reported accidents occur inside the blocks. This can happen when the level of supervision is relaxed. We have reduced the level of accidents by bringing this information to your attention.

Dormitories

- Be vigilant – jumping or climbing on bunks can cause accidents
- Make sure everyone is aware of fire exits
- All luggage should be stored in the luggage room
- Fire exits must never be blocked
- Fire doors must never be propped open
- Fire extinguishers should never be tampered with
- Take care when opening windows

Classrooms / common rooms

- Please don't allow children too walk about carrying drinks, trays are provided for adults to use.
- Only staff should unplug or move electrical equipment.
- Ensure leads do not cause a trip hazard
- Children should not be allowed to use the kettle
- Do not allow drinks near computers or other electrical appliances
- Do not allow climbing on veranda rails as this can cause accidents

Showers

- Check the temperature of the water before allowing young children to use the showers
- Beware of wet slippery floors (or uneven surfaces)
